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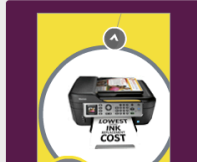
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Machine Wash Your Bras Safely

We've been testing the **Berry Ball** as a grown-up exercise. One thing I don't miss about my 20s? Cheap lingerie. In my 40s I feel my "girls" and I deserve beautiful, supportive bras—and that means they cost more than \$14.99 at Victoria's Secret. Yes, I should hand wash them—but who has the time? I have relied on a system of lingerie bags and rinsing in the shower. Not a perfect solution. Now I've got **The Berry Ball**.

I'm on a mission to save my delicates with the Berry Ball & Bag. It's a clever system that allows me to wash my wash bras and panties in the washing machine. The colorful ball is vented. I have tested my padded (don't make fun I'm a 34A) and underwire bras and use the mesh Berry Bag for bottoms.



After six washes (cold wash, gentle detergent, line dry), all my undergarments look great and the ball looks pretty sturdy. The complete care set retails for \$13.99 in specialty stores throughout the U.S. and online at ComfortHouse.com (www.comforthouse.com/berryball.html).
